- Space for 30 vendors
- Local Priest River area products, 1 vendor from WA
- Special events held throughout the summer (e.g. live music, drum circles, etc.)

Selling at Market:

- Registration required to sell
- 10x10 space: \$10
- 10x15 space: \$14
- 10x10 space: \$17
- Tax form required
- No resale, unless vendor gets own license

- Fresh fruit & veggies
- Handmade crafts
