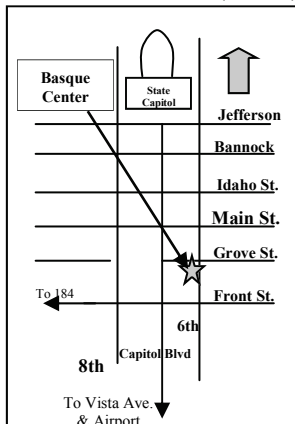

The conference is being held in beautiful downtown Boise where, like most cities, parking is at a premium. Those conference participants staying in downtown are urged to walk the few blocks from their lodging to the Basque center. Those attending the Friday session may park in the numerous parking structures located around the downtown (first hour free, \$1.50 per hour after), or the surface parking lots near the Basque Center (\$3 per day). On Saturday and Sunday, metered street parking is free and readily available, especially early in the day.
